Each volume is about 7in. x 9in. and usually contains 85 folios. Entries were generally written on the right-hand pages only, the opposite pages being used occasionally for later notes, sketches, etc. Many entries are updated, especially those that occurred prior to 1840. An index can be found at the end of each volume. A separate index volume was compiled by Sir Stephen Richard Glyne c.1840, which lists the churches visited in each county in chronological order, and (from 1840) gives the date of the visit.
