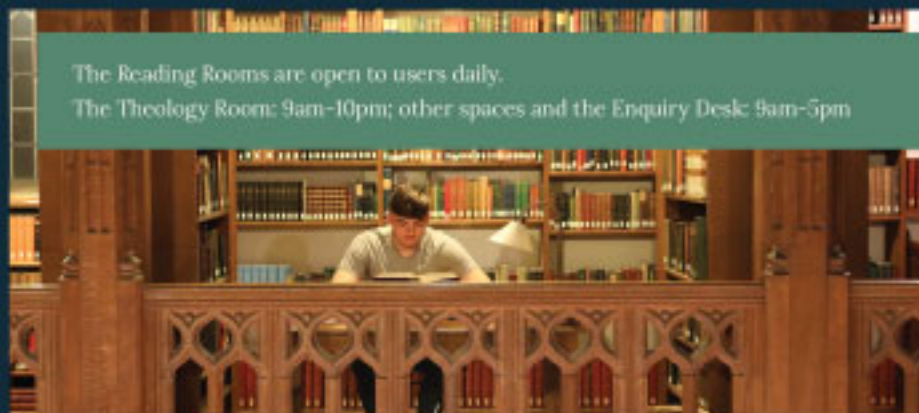


# Your £10 donation means a lot to us.
